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

Key Highlights




Travel recovery broadening out, supporting demand for aircraft in every region

Balance sheet continues to improve supported by resilient cash collections and strong equity generation

Supply constraints are likely to persist for the foreseeable future, supporting leasing demand

Growing Number of Countries Reopening

Relaxation of restrictions is allowing traffic growth to normalize around the world



- There has been significant progress in the reopening of borders in recent months
- Of the 190 countries where we track travel patterns, over half surpassed 80% of 2019 traffic levels in June 2022
- 27 countries are >100% of 2019 levels
- The re-opening of international markets will also boost transit and domestic connection activity


Strong and Resilient Cash Flows
